

SPRING CERTIFICATION OF INTENT TO ENTER THE JOB MARKET

Submit form to the Graduate Program Manager by February 15

The purpose of this form is to convert Teaching Assistant funding in Spring Quarter into a Dissertation Year University Fellowship (DYUF) for students intending to be on the job market next Fall.

It is not necessary to return this form if:

- The student has Spring Quarter funding (such as a fellowship, outside funding or a research assistantship) which they wish to retain. The student can then use the three quarters of DYUF funding eligibility in the Fall, Winter and Spring Quarters of their job market year.
- The student has already used at least one quarter of DYUF in a previous year.
- They are currently in years 6 or above (going on market in year 7 or above). These students are not eligible for DYUF funding.
