

How do I declare my minor in Economics?

1. Fill out a Declaration of Minor form and have it signed by any of the Economics advisors. The advisors have the forms in their office. Listing of advisors and walk-in office hours is at: <https://www.economics.northwestern.edu/undergraduate/student-services/advising-hours.html>
The department does not assign you an advisor, so you can go to any advisor at any time.
